

Code of Conduct

Basketballgrampian is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all its members. The association believes that it is important that members, coaches, officials, administrators, spectators, players and parents associated with basketballgrampian should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the association with Moyra Cowie (Chairperson).

As a member of **basketballgrampian** you are expected to abide by the following guidelines:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents.
- All members, parents and supporters will conduct themselves in an orderly fashion and refrain from using language that is considered to give offense to others.
- All members should keep to agreed timings for competitions or inform their opposition manager and/or match officials if they are going to be late.
- All members must wear suitable uniforms for matches, as laid out in FIBA rules.
- All members must pay any fees for competitions and events promptly.
- Members are not allowed to take drugs or alcohol of any kind whilst representing or taking part in any competition associated with **basketballgrampian**.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke whilst representing **basketballgrampian** at any competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol whilst representing **basketballgrampian**.

In addition, **basketballscotland**'s Code of Conduct applies in all **basketballscotland** events and competitions.
